Please exercise your usual care while collecting road-side debris. Watch for vehicles. Wear gloves. Use reachers or similar to grab garbage. Wear bright clothing or a safety vest if you have one. Don't pick up anything suspicious, "gooey", or too large to carry by hand.

Free collection bags will be available ALL MONTH. We will celebrate our spruced up town on Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup> with our annual Dahlia Club Plant & Bake Sale from 8 AM to 2 PM At the Bennett Fire Hall.

### **BENNETT RECYCLE YES!**

- Glass Food Containers and Lids
- Plastics 1-7 (# in triangle on bottom)
- Tin, Aluminum, Metal Cans, & Containers
- Loose paper, Newspaper, Magazines, Mail, and Flattened Light Cardboard
- Flattened Heavy Cardboard

**Note: All shredded paper in sealed bags; (paper bags preferred)**

### **RECYCLE NO**

- No Styrofoam (bits or containers)
- No plastic, flimsy bags of any sort\*
- No Hangers – any kind
- No used tissues or paper towels
- No pottery, china or leaded glass
- No plant matter

**Note: Styrofoam bits & peanuts should be bagged for trash or taken to a mail service for re-use.**

**\*Plastic bags can be collected and recycled at Walmart and other local food stores.**
